Advocacy Committee [4 min]

Updates and announcements

- Postdoc compensation
 - Ongoing discussions between YPA, YBPA, Advocacy, and the OPA
 - OPA is revising the announced compensation policy for 2024
 Waiting to hear their updates may happen as soon as today (May 14, 2024)
 - We are advocating for an equitable compensation scheme accounting for postdoc experience.
- OISS has updated their website, confirming that they encourage multi-year visas.
 - https://oiss.yale.edu/for-departments/inviting-a-scholar/appointment-dates-and-funding
 PI's are still unclear about what is needed for multi-year visas, especially when it comes to funding for them. Needs to be clarified by OPA or OISS—communications need to be sent to faculty.

PI must prove that they have the funding for a post doc available for duration of the Visa, based on the postdoc minimum salary. This amount is \$68,000 per post doc per year, plus the cost of health insurance/benefits. The committee will work on clarifying this with faculty.

Still working on compensation and PTO policy – no current updates

Open Forum - Questions/Comments [15 min]

Sudheesh's co-chair term is ending in July. YPA is looking for new co-chair – eligibility criteria are available on website under the bylaws. Reach out to Sudheesh and Laura with any questions.

Advocacy: Self-defense classes are all separate Yale Connect Events so need to sign up for each specific class separately. If you registered for the first, you will still need to register for each session you also want to attend.

Question asked about link for cross-campus resource. Only undergrads, grads and staff have access to it. Responded that OPA is currently working on it.

Also question about a separate daycare facility for postdocs that considers their payscale. The co-chairs said they can start advocating for this through OPA if this is something they can do. The advocacy coordinator suggested joining the advocacy committee and adding this issue to the agenda of the advocacy committee. This can be added to advocacy committee's agenda to get their help with this.

Academic job search series topics were questioned – do the postdocs at Yale worry about their first year as faculty or are they more concerned about how to prepare to find that job? Before preparing to be faculty, the person suggested that first postdocs need help getting an offer because this is more challenging. They mentioned that incoming professors get training for their expectations and duties, so the person suggested that the series should focus on finding jobs, getting offers, how to stand out in a Zoom interview, how to get and negotiate an offer instead. Person suggested they are more concerned with those topics because once the offer comes, there is already training built into a new faculty position. These would be more urgent needs (the next step for those who want to be faculty). Chairs responded by suggesting reaching out to OPA to make these requests about preparing for academic job market. Person who raised this topic also suggested that the grant writing workshop

should be expanded to have more open spots and multiple sessions since it's important for postdocs. The person also suggested soliciting postdocs for the specific topics they need. The chairs responded that the grant writing workshop costs a certain amount of money, but they will figure out if the grant class can happen twice per year instead of once, potentially. The chair also pointed out Yale Office of Career Strategy and UCLA and other university online resources that are free for all of the job prep steps.

A person asked if OPA has resource for adjunct positions available around Yale. OPA said they are occasionally emailed these openings but that the Poorvu center for Teaching and Learning would be a better resource for that.
