### Advocacy Committee [4 min]

- OISS has updated their <u>website</u>, confirming they encourage multi-year Visas.
  - OISS encourages all departments, when appropriate, to request the longest DS-2019 period possible if there is an intention to re-appoint a postdoctoral trainee beyond the

length of their current initial appointment. The maximum allowable length for J-1 Research Scholars is 5 years and for J-1 Short Term Scholars is 6 months.

• If your supervisor plans to reappoint you for another year after your first year, and they have the funds, they can ask for 5-year visa. That is not necessarily a commitment for a 5-year appointment.

Brianna Jackson (Assistant Director) and I are also informing admins when we have meetings about appointments, providing context on why this is beneficial for everyone, and answering any questions.

- Discussing Advocacy's feedback on compensation and the proposed PTO policy change with leadership. My plan is to be able to announce compensation minimums on April 15. The PTO policy will take more time, so that will be sent out later.
  - Compensation minimum changes will go into effect at the start of the next fiscal year (on July 1). Your next increase will be seen at your annual reappointment, as usual.

### **Open Forum - Questions/Comments [15 min]**

Q. For the annual raise, will there be funds provided to help advisors cover the cost increase, as with the raise last year?

A. Erin Heckler answered. No, there will be no funds provided to help the advisors. Last year was an exception due to the large increase in salary.

Q. When would be the earliest time the salary increase would go into effect for postdocs/ARS? A. Erin Heckler answered. The salary increase will go into effect starting July first for new postdocs, and upon any reappointments after July 1 2024, you will get an annual raise.

The concern was raised that postdocs whose reappointment falls between now and July 1 2024 will be paid less than those who are reappointed in July for the duration of a whole year.

Erin pointed out that this has always been the case, except for the large salary increase last year. Erin suggested that postdocs/ARS try to negotiate your rate to be higher than the current 2.5% if your reappointment falls before the increase on July 1.

After the July increase, the minimum increase will be automatically applied for all postdocs/ARS at their reappointment.

Another concern was raised that for postdocs/ARS who are reappointed before July 1, their salary could be lower than that of incoming postdocs, even if these postdocs were experienced and had seniority.

Erin responded that there is not a way change this operating withing the percent yearly increase structure (which is a new policy that postdocs/ARS requested to be put in place).

Attendees asked whether they could be reappointed at the current salary increase, and then have their salary increased again on July 1<sup>st</sup>.

Erin responded that receiving two salary increases within a fiscal year was not possible.
