Running into hurdle because the postdoctoral fellows don't get W2, just 1099, so they are not considered as Yale employees making it difficult to get benefits. Working with OPA to figure out a better way to get post doc associates and fellows get the same benefits.

Gym membership:

Trying to get subsidized gym membership for all post docs and it depends on the next OPA fiscal year budget.

- Paid time off and Sick leave policy update
 - Update will be announced by OPA soon.
- Salary scale update
 - Updated salary wil be communicated by OPA soon.
- Visa/Sevi fee reimbursement policy
 - Trying to establish hardship fund to get international visa costs reimbursed.
- Postdocs can ask for multi-year visa.
 - It is best to ask for a multi-year visa, so you don't have to renew it every year cutting the cost for international postdocs.
- Yale Transit update Trying to extend Yale Shuttle routes and actively working on it.
 - In addition, postdocs should use the "Yale accessible Transit Van" services during night or odd hours to go back home.

Officers said we should tell every post doc this info. And that this is the OISS's official position to have multi-year visas.

Hoping to make this a collective work – can pitch ideas to advocacy committee members and they can then add it to the document.

Someone raised their hand to request that we set something up with public safety office to have people register their bikes so it's easier to recover stolen bikes – Sudheesh said this process is already in place at Yale and it's possible they can organize an event or get the public safety office to come to us to make this more organized and accessible for YPA member/post docs.

Ongoing Advocacy work includes working with the Chairs/OPA to push for:

- Improved grievance procedure
- Improved Yale Shuttle experience and routes
- A postdoc rate for Payne-Whitney gym
- Improved postdoc access to therapy (having a designated therapist for post docs)
- Increase annual PTO and secure consistent recess days (or days in lieu) for all postdocs/ARS

Open Forum - Questions/Comments [15 min]

- If you face problems with visas, reach out to Chairs, OPA (Erin and Victoria), or Advocacy committee.
- Foreign tax office of university: someone raised their hand and said they're rude and not helpful.
 - OPA representative said this is likely because they can't legally give useful tax advice, so she suggested going to the event organized by YBPA and Advocacy committee.
 - International post docs are given a fake/temporary SSN to be able to access the Yale system. This number has to be manually updated with the real/official SSN—if not done, can cause many problems. Reach out to yale employee services
 (203-432-5552 or employee.services@yale.edu) to ask for corrections and a corrected W2 (W-2c).
- Final shuttle doesn't let you know when it's the last run and sometimes drivers take you to
 the Peabody Museum (a different final destination) and tell you they are off the clock. Chair
 recommended filing a complaint with the Yale public safety
 (https://your.yale.edu/community/public-safety/contact-us), Yale transit office
 (https://your.yale.edu/work-yale/campus-services/yale-transit/contact-us) and
 OPA to
 report this. They will request the number of the bus, bus line color and time.
 - Please continue to report this to the OPA and YPA chairs plan is to write a letter to the Yale Transportation office
 - Chair also recommended calling the Yale Accessible Transit a taxi door-to-door on-demand service when you are stranded/need a ride
 - For international Postdocs, reach out to OISS as they also are compiling info on Yale Shuttle services
