Past events

- *Workshop in salary negotiation*: Dr. Anees Chagpar: 1h negotiation workshop 101. June 27th on Zoom from 4-5pm. 43 participants (~50% of total registrations), very good feedback. Possibility to organize an in-person event in the future with Dr. Chagpar based on feedback.
- "Balancing Motherhood and Academic Pursuits" with Stephanie Kramer and Kirsten Isgro, June 20th, panel discussion (4:30-6pm) + reception (6-7:30pm), in person at Sterling Memorial Library (reception). This event was conducted in collaboration with the Belonging Committee, Women Faculty Forum, Yale Worklife, and Yale Women in Medicine and Science. 27 people attended the session. One piece of feedback for such events longer than an hour was to preferentially hold it closer to lunch.

- One issue brought up by this piece of feedback is that the timing of events can exclude parents that need to pick up children from childcare at the end of the workday. Evening events are particularly challenging. Suggested solutions included:
 - Organize as many events as possible over lunch during the weekdays.
 - Host child-friendly events.
 - For longer events, try scheduling them on a weekend.
 - YSB and the humanities quad allows you to reserve spaces on the weekend free of charge, for other spaces you might need to use a COA to pay. Please reach out to the Chairs of Secretaries if you need help identifying a space for a weekend event on campus.

- YPA advocacy social media campaign
 - Twitter engagement statistics:
 - The most popular post was the one demonstrating that Yale's PTO policies are significantly limited compared to other Ivy League institutions.
 - Tagging many Yale-affiliated accounts on YPA posts was successful at spreading the message.
 - A strategy to effectively get Yale to pay attention to these social media campaigns is to get friends who are postdocs at other Ivy League universities to retweet/reblog, tagging their university and Yale, and brag about how much better their university policies are compared to Yale's.
 - Instagram engagement statistics:
 - Accounts that viewed the YPA stories were usually non-followers.
 - The most recent social media campaign got much more engagement than usual (1000 impressions compared to the usual 200-400).

Mentorship Committee [4 min]

- Committee meeting held on 6/28/2024.
 - Peer-mentoring: monthly meetings over four months
 - This is a program where postdocs gather together and discuss different job tracks.
 - Two divisions:
 - Academia at least 4 people attended regularly.

- Industry only two meetings, because they did not have experienced peers who could offer mentoring.
- Improvements: we will look for mentors (e.g., former Yale postdocs)
- Buddy Program.
 - Party in May 10 people attended, mentors received certificates.
 - About 60 people involved in the program this year
 - The buddy program pairs a new postdoc with a current postdoc to help them settle in at New Haven and become familiarized with Yale and all of the opportunities offered.
- Faculty-postdoc mentoring program.
 - It runs for 8 months 8 meetings.
 - About 50 postdocs per year, about 25 are active.

Reaction to current Yale <u>compensation</u> and PTO policies

- Posts on social media to draw attention to our issues. In collab with the communications committee.
- We appreciate it if you share those posts so that we can reach a wider audience.
- There won't be any policy changes made by Yale until at least the next fiscal year.
 - The primary issue identified by the Advocacy Committee with respect to this policy, is that policies should apply equally to everyone, and it should not matter whether or not you were appointed in March or September.
- If you are being reappointed, and you think that your PI will hear you out, you can:
 - ask for a (potentially retroactive) increase in pay match the \$68,000 base pay of an incoming first year plus an amount that reflects yearly raises to reach the number of years of experience that you have.
 - Please reach out to the Advocacy Committee coordinators or chairs if you have further questions.

The Advocacy Committee is targeting enhanced retirement benefits and PTO for postdocs as well.

Comment from an attendee: make sure your letter of reappointment has your correct salary listed. You can double check this on workday. This letter comes from your department. Reach out to department admins if you haven't received your letter.

Comment from the Chairs: even if your reappointment letter after July doesn't take into account the incoming raise to \$68,000, OPDA will automatically apply it. Please double-check your paychecks to ensure that your raise wasn't missed by the OPA.

Comment from Advocacy Committee member: You're supposed to be given 3 months' notice if your contract is not being renewed unless the reason is underperformance. To maintain a record of your satisfactory performance, please complete and submit your yearly IDP that is sent to you as part of your reappointment. This will document that your performance was satisfactory over the past years and will prevent your contract from being suddenly not renewed.
