## Chairs [5 min]

- o Happy Valentines!
- Executive Board meet and greet (Feb 7th) report
  - o The meeting on Feb 7<sup>th</sup> had full attendance!
- Postdoc Salaries
  - o There is a wave of salary increases across various institutions. YPA is also discussing taking action and plans to engage in more discussions with the administration.
- Trainee Accommodations Committee (TAC) meetings updates
  - o The TAC committee involves the YPA chairs and 2 advocacy committee members. YPA raises issues on behalf of postdocs, such as salary changes, increases in the cost of living, etc.
  - o We are also discussing the possibility of a dining hall for the postdocs. Currently, each college has a dining hall for the undergrads, while postdocs can only access it as guests. We would like to have access to dining halls close to our departments. YPA will get in touch with the managers of the dining halls.

### Secretaries [2 min]

- Introduction and update on YPA Inventory.
  - o Ahmed introduced the YPA inventory and encouraged committee coordinators to fill it in. The purpose of the inventory is to keep tabs on the YPA items, evaluate the needs for storage, and request more space for YPA items if needed. An e-mail with the link to the inventory has already been sent to committee coordinators.

- New ordering procedure (P-card)
  - o An important announcement related to the new ordering procedure is made. Committees should make sure that related information reaches each of their members and that everyone is updated.

- O As of now (February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023), all purchases will be made through the YPA P-card. The treasurers will execute the purchasing orders, which will be submitted through a request form, via Yale Connect. For any purchases, a request order must be done a week in advance to give treasurers sufficient time to process and approve. The request form needs to be filled with all the necessary information, including the details of the event, the number of attendees, the costs, the number of items to be purchased, the correct address of delivery, etc. Nevertheless, in the case of urgent items, treasurers can be contacted directly to discuss the possibility of ordering sooner.
- o Question: How will the alcohol purchases be made since they must be made in person?
- o Answer: We do not yet have a clear answer for it. As a possibility, P-card can be given to committees other than the treasurers, however, this will be discussed.
- Outstanding reimbursement.
  - From today onwards, future purchases made by individual committees may not be reimbursed. All outstanding reimbursement claims should be completed by the end of this week (week 7 of the calendar year). The coordinators should share this announcement with all their members.

  - o Answer: The survey will allow us to bring the issues surrounding the postdoc community up to the administration and help us push policies to improve the conditions of postdocs. The main problems to be addressed are financial hardship

- (compensation and benefits), and workplace dynamics (harassment and reporting it). The survey overall will facilitate YPA to serve better.
