Chairs [15 min]

- Welcome & introduction to check-in track of Open Forum Attendance

o The minimum salary will increase from 56K to 65K, which is substantial, and a reflection of the value Postdocs bring to Yale. The salary change is being implemented as the outcome of the dialogue between the Yale leadership and YPA (The Advocacy Committee, as well as the YBPA).

Open Forum - Questions/Comments [15 min]

Questions to Erin Heckler about the new compensation and fellowships:

- o Question: If the mentor has access to non-federal funds, do they receive the subsidy? Answer: Yes.
- o Question: What if the fellowship funding is from the home country? Answer: This complicates how the supplement is provided. The policy needs to be checked first, whether the fellowship holder can receive the supplement. If the answer is yes, then the supplement will be given.
- o Question: Does the increase apply to ARS? Answer: This should be discussed with faculty affairs.
- o The YPA is trying to improve Postdoc access to the PWG: Currently, the Postdocs pay as faculty. The YPA is looking into some subsidies and free access passes.
- o Question: About the symposium: How does the P-card work with COAs? Answer: The YPA has COA. Please reach out to the chairs or the treasurers.
- o Question: How is the Google Drive reorganization going to be done? Answer: The reorganization is not entirely planned yet. The idea is that there would be an overall restructuring of the Drive and not the individual folders of each committee. Those folders should be organized by the committee itself.
