## Associate Provost for Postdoctoral Affairs, Erin Heckler [5 min]

- Postdoc Survey opened May 25; first in a series of on-campus events was at the Humanities Quad on Monday June 12
  - o Erin encouraged everyone to take some fliers advertising the postdoc survey and to post them around the campus. The survey should be filled out minimum by 30% of postdocs. As of the Open Forum date, the percentage was much lower.
  - o Erin explained that Survey Parties were meant as small events to fill the survey together along with free coffee and cookies.

  - o As of the Open Forum date, only 2 people registered, Erin encouraged registration to this event.

# **Open Forum - Questions/Comments [20 min]**

- O Question to Erin Heckler by Anna: When the YPA budget for the upcoming year will be finalized? Answer: Erin explained that they were still working on it and the YPA will receive it as soon as it's ready. Furthermore, historically YPA requests a reasonable budget, therefore the budget allocated this year should be like that of last year. One alteration is that the YPA might have to cut back on happy hours. Erin recommended that the YPA have a finalized budget to propose to the OPA in the fall, which will leave enough time for the approval process.
- o Question to Erin Heckler: Are there any mandatory mentorship trainings for the faculty? Answer: Formally mandating training for faculty is nearly impossible. Nevertheless, there are efforts to highlight the need for it. Improving the mentorship of faculty requires a culture change and possibly peer pressure. For instance, the

- mentorship awards are an effort in that direction. Some schools post which faculties complete mentorship training to promote mentorship efforts and to inform trainees.
- o A question to Erin Heckler was directed about the Yale Alcohol policy. Answer: Erin highly recommended bartenders and no hard alcohol. Erin also suggested having happy hours off campus, and having attendees pay for their own alcohol while using the YPA budget for appetizers.
- O Question to the general audience: Is it possible to form a post-doc support group and would anybody be interested in a support group? Advocacy committee answered that they are advocating for a dedicated licensed counselor for postdocs. The audience alternatively suggested an informal support group with regular meetings. Nicole highlighted the importance of doing the postdoc survey to draw more attention to the support needed for postdoc mental health.
- Question: What is the retirement policy options for Post-Docs? Answer: Associates can contribute to a 403b, but with no university match. This allows you to contribute pre-tax. Fellows expressed frustration at having no options for retirement. There were requests for a clearer guideline on Post-Doc benefits (and taxes) to be posted in an accessible place, and/or be more clearly discussed during Post-Doc orientation. Advocacy committee announced that they may try to do a tax advice workshop. Erin Heckler recommended that they would need to get an outside expert since the OPA is not allowed to give tax advice, but the YPA can and should organize a tax workshop. It would also be beneficial to have a seminar on benefits overview for postdoc associates/fellows.
- o Question: Could YPA organize an "associate to fellow" transition guide? Answer: There already is a guide, albeit outdated, on the advocacy website. Erin Heckler proposed that the OPA take the advocacy guide, expand it, and then crowdsource from all postdocs for more updates.
