THE YALE POSTDOCTORAL ASSOCIATION MONTHLY MEETING



Tuesday, July 11, 2023 | 6:00 PM



Attendance: 29 registered, 27 checked-in.

Chairs [5 min]

- Welcome and Introduction
 - o The chairs gave a brief introduction into the purpose of the Open Forum, and how these meetings operate. The chair explained how the forum is a space for the committee chairs to present events they have successfully organized, to introduce events that are upcoming, and to discuss the evolving goals of each committee and how those goals align with the broader goals of the YPA. At the end of the forum there is time set aside for any attendee to raise questions or concerns that they have.
 - o The chairs encouraged all attendees to sign in via the QR code, so that an accurate count of attendees will be recorded.
 - o The chairs welcomed the new coordinators, as all new coordinator's terms began this month, and thanked them for volunteering their time.
- Survey Results and Discussion
 - o The chairs introduced the Post Doc Survey, which was a collaboration between the YPA advocacy committee and the OPA (Office for Postdoctoral Affairs). The

goal of the survey is to thoroughly capture the details of the lives and primary concerns of Post-Docs and ARS's at Yale are, so that the YPA and OPA can better identify and advocate for the needs of Post-Docs at Yale. This is the first time this survey is being carried out, so it is important that as many people as possible respond, and to take the time to answer in detail.

- o There have been over 300 survey responses thus far, and the YPA and OPA have a goal of 400 replies. Again, this will help identify issues that Post-Docs have that the YPA can address better.
- Executive Board Meeting: August 1st, 6 PM (Executive Board Members Only)
 - o The chairs are currently planning a meeting for the Executive Board to go over training and roles for the committee coordinators, as well as the mission of each committee and the YPA. The Executive Board are the coordinators of the various committees. The meeting will be hybrid, but coordinators are encouraged to attend in person to facilitate networking. An email with further details, including location, will be sent out shortly.
 - o The chairs announced that there will be a diversity, equity, and inclusion meeting forthcoming, details TBD.
- Bylaws Meeting: August 8th, 7 PM (Executive Board Members Only)
 - o The chairs announced that there will be a meeting for the Executive Board members only after next month's Open Forum, the goal of which will be to work together to revise the YPA bylaws. This occurs yearly to keep the association on track and involves going over which points are working and which points need updating.
- Professional behavior reminder
 - o The chairs reminded everyone that all coordinators are volunteers and donating their time, asked everyone to be courteous in their email communications with committee members, and be mindful of everyone's time.

Secretaries [2 min]

- Please update the <u>YPA committee members</u> list for your committees.
 - o The secretarial team asked coordinators of each committee to update their roster on the linked google doc above. This facilitates easy communication between all committees.
- YPA Google Drive Organization:
 - o The secretarial team will be organizing an update of the YPA google drive. The current plan is to archive all files and folders from previous years, and create one single folder for each committee, as well as a folder for YPA handbooks. Each committee can then (re)populate their folder with relevant subfolders and documents.
 - o The secretarial team is open to other suggestions about the above plan, and encouraged attendees to reach out to the secretarial team if they have suggestions or concerns.

- Assisting the committees with tasks.

o The secretarial team has expanded, and we now have the personnel to be able to assist other committees with various tasks, including room booking, food ordering, and more. Please reach out to the secretarial team if you have anything in mind or have any suggestions.

Treasury [5 min]

- Go over purchasing practices.
 - o The treasurers walked through the new purchasing guidelines (found <u>here</u>). The treasurers must now make purchases on a credit card (pcard), and so they require more advance notice than they used to.
 - o The preferred method of submitting a purchase request is by using this YPA Connect submission form. The treasurers look at this form once a week, on Mondays, so committee members are encouraged to be sure that they submit this form at least a week in advance of when the purchase needs to be made.
 - o The treasurers will send an email shortly containing all the information about the new purchasing guidelines to the committee members.
- Introduce Rafael Lopes Paixao da Silva as a new treasurer candidate.
 - o There were no objections to Rafael as the new treasurer.
 - o Anna York will continue as a treasurer for a few more months, to assist in finalizing the changes to the YPA purchasing practices. There will be three treasurers for the next few months.
- New budgets.
 - o Treasurers announced that the YPA budget for the 2023-2024 fiscal year was approved by the OPA last week. There will be \$38,500 in total, divided among the different committees.
 - o Committees will be updated by email about their allocated budgets, so that event planning for the upcoming year can begin in earnest.
 - o The OPA requires significant lead-time in the budget approval process, so going forward the YPA will plan to submit their budgets for the upcoming fiscal years in the fall.
 - To get back in sync, the YPA is planning to submit the budget for the 24-25 fiscal year to the OPA in a few months.
 - Please be on the lookout for a forthcoming email from the treasurers asking for each committee's budget.
 - o Treasurers announced that they will assist committee coordinators in preparing the budgets for the 24-25 fiscal year in the upcoming Executive Board Meeting and will also walk through a training on using the new pcard for YPA purchases.

- o Committee coordinators thanked outgoing coordinators and members.

 - o There were no objections.
- Welcome new members: Sabrina, Akbar, and Vahid
 - Coordinators called for people to join this committee.
- Reminder to complete the Postdoc Experience Survey
 - o Coordinators described the process of designing the survey. The YPA Chairs, the Advocacy Committee and the OPA worked together over the course of 5 months to construct this survey.
 - o There have been 300 responses so far. The YPA needs 400-450 to reach a 30% response rate.
 - o The answers will help the YPA advocate for Post-Docs and ARSs. Responding will help the YPA and OPA understand Post-Docs concerns regarding discrimination, harassment, grievance procedures, as well as family concerns. This will be a way to provide a better experience for all Post-Docs and ARSs.

 - Ombuds Statement published on YPA website
 - o To generate the successfully published Ombuds statement, the Advocacy Committee followed the YPA bylaws procedures- inputs from various committees were solicited, and the proposed statement went to YPA members form approval. There were 130 votes to support the statement.
 - This statement asks Yale to implement an Ombuds office for Yale Post-Docs and ARSs. The Ombudsperson will provide impartial grievance support for Yale Post-Docs. Yale is currently the only Ivy League institution that does not have an ombuds office for Post-Docs.

Associate Provost for Postdoctoral Affairs, Erin Heckler [5 min]

- Finances:
 - FY24 budget approval

- o The fiscal year for the YPA and the OPA starts July 1st and runs through June 30th (in line with semesters).
- o The budget for FY 23-24 has recently been approved.
- FY25 Process (FY = fiscal year July 1 June 30)
 - o The OPA goal is to try to align the YPA budget and the Post-Grad Association budget with the office budget, so this will move the approval process to the fall (as the treasurers discussed earlier)
 - o Erin urged the YPA to work on budgets for the 24-25 fiscal year ASAP.

 - o As the YPA grows and organizes more events, it becomes more challenging to manage all the purchases. The goal of these updated practices is to streamline things for both treasurers and coordinators.

Open Forum - Questions/Comments [15 min]

Chairs thank the secretaries for organizing the agenda for the meeting, and ordering the pizza. Chairs welcome all new members to the various committees, and to the YPA.

Question: How might the YPA increase attendance from non-committee members? The Open Forum events seem to be lacking general attendees that are not part of committees, and this is counter to one of the major goals of the Open Forum, which is for all Post-Docs to have the opportunity to raise issues and suggest ways that the YPA can help the community.

Related Question: How might we keep track of who is attending events, so that we can identify the distribution of committee members and non-committee member attending various YPA organized events?

Suggestions to address this issue include:

- o Rotating campuses to make it easier for people to attend at least a few events near their place of work. The YPA recently switched to doing this and will be sure to maintain this when planning the Open Forum Schedule for the 2023-2024 academic year.
- o Committee members can reach out to their co-workers, increase physical visibility of the Open Forum by hanging flyers in departments and breakrooms. Deep canvassing to make the YPA more visible.
- o Committee members can attempt to bring a friend to the Open Forum meetings.
- o Mining departmental list-servs, as well as the symposium committee's compiled list of emails
 - o Counterpoint was raised that Post-Docs receive a lot of emails, and it's clear that not everyone reads or responds to them. Perhaps a way of reaching out to new attendees that doesn't involve emails would be more effective.
- o Erin Heckler from the OPA suggested surveying current coordinators about why they joined their committees, to help target ways to encourage new members.
