## Symposium Committee [3 min]

- Summary of the feedback from the 6th Symposium
  - o The feedback was overall very positive. The attendees appreciated the photographer and the diversity of topics. One criticism was that the talks were too specific. The symposium committee will take all the feedback into account for next year's Symposium.
- Introduction of new members
  - o The Symposium committee announces the recruitment of three new members to their committee. Since the Symposium of 2022, they have 6 more members.
- Budget allocation
  - o The committee is satisfied with the new budget they are allocated but they also expect an increase of costs due to inflation. They plan to reduce the budget used for IT services. Holding the Symposium in a hybrid format generates significant IT costs (approximately 100 USD per hour). They are planning to switch from a hybrid to only in-person meeting to decrease the spending on audiovisuals. - Recap: Navigating Difficult Situations as a Postdoc
  - o This event had over 30 attendees and it was highly engaging.

- Chronic Illness and Disability Aid & Protection for Postdocs Guest Speaker
  - The advocacy committee introduced their guest speaker Ana Lucia Rodriguez De La Rosa, who is an ARS at Yale. Ana shared her experience of living with a chronic illness. When she was diagnosed with cancer, her ARS status became a problem as the ARS is not covered in the faculty manual or in Yale Benefits. She had to navigate the system on her own and communicate with several offices. As it is, most decisions hang on the courtesy of the PIs, which should not be the case. Ana advocates for cancer patients and made the following suggestions: ARS and Postdocs should have the benefits to cover their treatments, and they need to receive immigration support in order not to have to leave the country in the middle of their therapy. Benefits should also cover transportation services, housing services, child support, travel, and visa guidance. Ana gave the example of NIH retention grants which are given to support researchers during critical life events and suggested that Yale could also implement such measures to protect Postdocs experiencing these major events.
  - o The Advocacy Committee will organize events together with Ana to raise awareness and Ana will also share her experience with the OPA.

# Special Guest: English Studies programs at the Center for Language Study – James Tierney [5 min]

- o James Tierney and Lauri Lafferty introduced English language programs available for Postdocs.
- o The Center for Language Study is at the corner of Temple and Grove (Dow Hall, 370 Temple Street) and has been serving postdocs with no fee for years. They have courses tailored to the needs of postdocs, which include writing, pronunciation, and fluency classes. The courses are offered at different levels, primarily for those who speak English as a second language. Morning and evening classes are available and will begin in mid-September. There are orientation meetings in small groups to see who could benefit from which course. James Tierney and Lauri Lafferty encourage everyone to spread the word to those who could benefit from these courses.

## **Open Forum - Questions/Comments [15 min]**

- o Question by Benoit: Can the hybrid events be accessible to those not affiliated with Yale, such as for other Postdoc Associations? Answer: Erin explains that this would depend on the event itself. Specific events designed for Yale postdocs may not be suitable for external audiences but others could very well be. For instance, the Academic Bullying event was open to external attendees.
