# Chairs [4 min]

### Welcome

- The YPA Open Forum occurs the second Tuesday of every month. Committees present planned events for the month, and at the end of the meeting 15 minutes are reserved to field questions and concerns from the Yale Post-doc community.
- Chairs encouraged new attendees to reach out to coordinators if they are interested in joining any committees.

### • YPA Bylaws

- The YPA Bylaws were approved last month, after going through the yearly review process (outlined <u>here</u>). There two major modifications are detailed below.
  - Two new committees were created: (1) Belonging and (2) Secretary.
  - A new section entitled "Accessibility at YPA events" was created.
    - Chairs asked coordinators to keep the policies outlined in this section in mind when planning events. The goal of these policies is to make sure that YPA events are accessible to everyone, and to provide resources to facilitate this.

### Open Co-chair position

- Cintia's term as Co-chair ends in December. There will be an election for a new Co-chair next month. If interested in running, eligibility requirements are outlined here and here.
- Reminder- New Co-Coordinators for each committee
  - Chairs reminded attendees that committees will need to look for new coordinators soon. Co-coordinator term is one year, and each co-coordinator overlaps with the other by six months, to facilitate transfer of knowledge.

- Trainee Accommodation Committee (TAC) Meeting on October 31st, 2023.
  - TAC was created during the COVID pandemic. The goal of this meeting is to create a time for the YPA co-chairs and the Advocacy committee coordinators to meet with Yale leadership (i.e. Deans from the different colleges) and advocate for trainee needs.
  - The current agenda for this meeting is to address Postdoc/ARS safety issues, and further discuss the recent salary increase.

### Treasury [4 min]

- Update on the current budget status.
  - The latest budget numbers can be found here.
  - The National Postdoc Association conference will be held next year. The YPA provides funding to send various committees to present the work their committee has done. This year the Community and Networking Committee will send representatives to present their accomplishments. Last year a representative from the Advocacy committee presented. And the year prior the Symposium committee presented.
  - Treasurers encouraged coordinators to submit their budget proposals ASAP, so that all proposals can be consolidated and sent to the OPA.
- Updates on order placement:
  - The OPA will be handling some orders (mostly Grubhub and Amazon) and we will need to start asking for orders 1-2 weeks in advance.
  - All orders (except for food delivery) will have to be delivered to OPA now and they will need to pick it up in person. Alternatively, the use of a physical P-card will be allowed. The instructions will be in the PPT sent to the coordinators.
  - Please plan your orders in advance and read the emails about the order status, we usually process the order on Monday mornings.
