Chairs [10 min]

- Welcome General and new Postdocs
 - The chairs welcomed everyone, introduced themselves, and briefly explained how the YPA Open Forum works.
 - o Reminder to check in using the QR code for the Yale Connect event.
 - o Everyone is invited to have pizza!
- Trainee Accommodations Committee (TAC) meeting debrief
 - o To address the safety concerns raised by Postdocs and ARSs, YPA asked to increase shuttle services, as well as the availability of door-to-door cab services. Yale will have to collect statistics on where people live and extend services accordingly.
 - The problems regarding ARS guidelines were brought forward by the YPA. There will be an effort to improve ARS guidelines.

- o YPA is also advocating for a therapist dedicated to Yale postdocs.
- o YPA asked for a yearly increase of postdoc salaries, based on the inflation rate. Although postdoc salaries increased in July 2023, currently there are only two scales, which are years 1 to 4 and years 5 to 6.
- o YPA is also collaborating with OPA to improve postdoc benefits, evaluating what other Ivy League postdocs receive as benefits.
- Appreciation meeting for committees
 - o The YPA chairs started an initiative of appreciation meetings to have coordinators connect with their respective committee members. Each committee will receive a budget to hold these appreciation meetings.
- New coordinators should be announced in December Open Forum
- Introducing the co-chair candidates
 - o Cintia's term as the co-chair will soon end. There are three candidates for the next Co-chair position. Each candidate introduced themselves and their goal as the next chair.
 - o The first candidate: Amanda Bentley-DeSousa. Amanda is in the Department of Cell Biology. She is currently the treasurer for the YPA, and she previously was also a secretary. She would like to take a bigger role in the YPA to help the postdoc community.
 - o The second candidate: Laura Santos: Laura is a second-year postdoc in the Department of MCDB. She is the co-coordinator of the Professional Development Committee and wishes to make Yale a better place for postdocs.
 - o The third candidate: Oksana Goroshchuk: Oksana is a postdoc in the Department of Neurology. She is a member of the Professional Development Committee and has been active in the YPA for the past 2.5 years. She advocates for postdoc benefits to include free/discounted access to Payne Whitney Gym. She would like to contribute to the bright life of postdocs.
 - o The next chair will be announced in the YPA Open Forum in December.
