Yale Postdoctoral Association Code of Conduct

- YPA is dedicated to providing a professional and welcoming environment that fosters diversity, equity, inclusion, and the free expression of ideas.
- This code of conduct is conceived to promote inclusion, protect individual liberties, and promote the free and frank expression of ideas.
- No part of this code shall be construed in such a way as to limit the good faith debate or expression of ideas, even when controversial.
- Participating in YPA events should be a rewarding experience for everyone.
- We do not tolerate harassment in any form.

Members asked to stop any harassing or otherwise undesired behavior are expected to comply immediately.

If members of the YPA Executive Board, or event organizers if no Executive Board members are present, determine that an individual has engaged in unacceptable behavior, it shall determine the appropriate action to be taken.

These actions include, but are not limited to:

- Expulsion from an event without warning or recompense
- Referral to appropriate Yale authorities or local law enforcement
- Prohibition from any future YPA event

YPA is dedicated to providing a professional and welcoming environment that fosters diversity, equity, inclusion, and the free expression of ideas.

To create a space that promotes equality and inclusiveness, the YPA expects all event participants to:

- Be respectful and considerate at all times.
- Value the diversity of views, ideas, and opinions.
- Critique ideas rather than individuals; avoid personal attacks directed toward others.
- Respect venue policies and personnel. (e.g. Yale buildings, restaurants, etc.)
- Be mindful of surroundings and of fellow participants.
- Alert security or emergency responders in case of a dangerous situation or someone in distress.
- Alert YPA leadership with concerns regarding violation of this code of conduct.

1. Mental Health First Aid: 2 min

Speed social: 1 min
Childcare: 6 min

- 1. Total 28 postdocs attended. Positive feedbacks (20% of the participates responded to feedback survey).
 - i. We will organize more mental health courses.
 - ii. Planning on more casual events—postdoc support group.
- 2. Speed social is this Thursday.
 - i. Potentially a monthly event.
- 3. Encouraging postdocs to use childcare.
 - i. 100 dollars reimbursed for up to 20 days.
 - ii. Only 66/1459 PDAs used crisis care although 292 PDAs are eligible. Only 4/221 PDFs used crisis care.
 - -Yale renews it on monthly bases. So it is important that many people use it to continue the program.
 - -Will send out quarterly email listing childcare benefits for postdoc and ARS.
 - -Will try to organize a short informational event.
 - -Another option: trying to get stipends for childcare with YCCC.

Symposium

You cannot get more than a 2 % increase in your salary unless your title changes when you apply for grants. Recommend having a discussion with your PI and the business office as well.
