Advocacy: [5 min]

- 1. Wellbeing Workshop poll [Chantal she/her/hers]
 - Advocacy committee chairs had a meeting with Being Well at Yale
 - They offer a diverse range of free workshops (example: diet and nutrition) held by visiting scholars
 - Summer Are these workshops they already have?
 - Yes, just a matter of setting time and advertising
 - Would like to start off with one workshop/semester if there's interest
 - Can do same or different topics each semester
 - The workshops could be 1 to 1.5 hours long
 - Live polls:
 - 1. Interest in topics: Highest response: Resilience and stress (other topics: mindfulness and meditation; joy and gratitude; diet and nutrition; sleep)
 - 2. What time works best? Highest response: 4-6 pm

- A lot of people are opening links pertaining to career development and jobs, as well as mentorship
- Looks like people are interested in looking for more information
- Audience about 1000, from many states, mostly from CT
- Opened by 56.8% of audience
- Twitter:
 - Increased tweets
 - o Twitter manager is doing a good job
 - o Increased Twitter followers, not as many as Facebook but will likely increase with Twitter manager
 - Audience is broad
 - o Summer What is an Impression?
 - o Sam Tweet was in someone's feed
- Facebook
 - Increased number of followers and views
 - o Alysa Facebook Reach is the same as Twitter impression
- 2. Podcast support position we need new members [Lina]
 - New initiative with Kyle, member of the committee
 - Want to do a podcast with other postdoctoral scholars or invited speakers
 - Looking for someone to help with editing
 - Thinking of having it regularly
 - Everyone is invited
 - Will generate forms to see what people are interested in terms of both topics and speakers
 - Can nominate guests, like established researchers
 - Form for yourself. If you want to talk about your own interests or anything else
 - Talked with Brian (OCS); there is a broadcast center at Yale. They can support us and others. Can upload to Spotify, etc. Anyone can access it, giving us a broader audience.
 - Very excited to start this
 - Feel free to reach out if you have ideas
 - Will give hints in terms of length, interview style, etc.
 - Don't want to completely restrict audience
 - Anna Could we personal experiences or points of view, such as settling in and other non-academic issues?
 - Lina Yes, Kyle tell us what you visualize
 - Kyle Two types of interviews. On would highlight a person (award, on the job market, etc). The other would include an invited speaker. People can talk about anything including adjusting to campus, what is elegant science, etc.

 - Postdoc Roundtable [Victor]

 - o Will send out invites
 - o Can discuss topics like current events
 - o This is a platform to engage in discussion
 - o Providing pizza because we have money to spend
 - o Plan to hold it every two months
 - o Can suggest topics for future iterations
 - o First topic: coordinators will come up with a few and see how it goes

- 3. Tomorrow will hold meeting to plan trips in spring like Mystic because we have extra money

Mentorship Committee: [7 min]

- 1. Updates
 - Peer mentoring program [Hada]
 - o First time organizing
 - o Was previously held last semester
 - o 36 postdoctoral scholars are on board for this iteration
 - o They are gathering to meet and get to know what the program is about
 - o Goal is to develop career skills for both academia and industry
 - o So far, there are 7 groups of about 5-7 people each; 2 groups have an industry focus, rest academic
 - o Have surveys to gauge engagement throughout
 - o Feel free to ask questions
 - o Summer Trying to integrate getting more feedback from groups
 - Mentorship training workshop [Summer]
 - o With John Alvaro
 - o This is the first time it will be held on Science Hill
 - o Will see how it goes
 - o Slower sign ups; took more emails to get people sign up
 - o Sam Might be because people think it's happening in the Medical School
 - o Able to get bigger room
 - o Difficult conversations will be held at the Medical School next month
 - Meet a mentor lunch
 - o One or two more mentors needed; please provide nominations
 - o Last Friday of the month might conflict with the roundtable
 - o Lina Events are on the calendar so we can avoid issues

Professional Development Committee: [5 min] (Eric)

- 1. Communication Workshop Series
 - Look out for information on this
 - Will send out poll to narrow down options in the next couple weeks
 - Will also highlight existing workshops held by the Center for Teaching/Learning (CTL)
 - When revamping will make sure that workshops reflect what postdoctoral scholars are most interested in
 - Will also try to pick topics that could help with the symposium such as public speaking

Treasury: [5 min] (Alysa)

- 1. FY 2021 budget has been tentatively approved!
 - Final budget is \$20,300
 - Up from approximately \$14,000, so this is a big increase
 - Took a look at the new budget
 - o Some committees have much bigger budgets, like Community and Networking and Advocacy
 - o Communications gets its own budget
 - o If anyone has not used up budget by end of June, please use it up
 - Erin The finalized budget will be sent to everyone and posted on Slack
- 2. Budget concerns brought up by the OPA Have already discussed this with committees
 - Sharing University resources
 - o Mainly concerned about Communications
 - o Can't use budget for podcast equipment or subscriptions for services because research funds come into this budget, and there are certain restrictions
 - o They did give suggestions of other University resources
 - Charity events
 - o There are tax implications if we as a nonprofit try to give a charity donation
 - o But might be able to work something out with Yale and United Way We can maybe have individuals give straight to charity instead of through YPA
 - YPA branded items/swag
 - o Concerned about the amount of budget proposed for this
 - o But have leftover funds from last sale
