Advocacy: [15 min]

- 1. Lab re-opening survey
 - Thanks Sean for all your work
 - Welcome Krishna as co-coordinator
 - Had the first survey regarding the COVID-19 related issues in March; had a follow-up survey in May
 - Discussed the survey results with John Alvaro, Lashaunda
 - Only 53% feel it is safe enough to return
 - 20% feel pressure to return (it's really difficult to avoid retaliation); Sean: Can't do anything about recommendation letters, but training policy up to dean to levy sanction on faculty members (but they are colleagues), so it's unlikely anything would happen

- Postdoctoral scholars report PI submissions of misleading reopening plans
- Shuttle availability/safety is unknown
- There has been no help with childcare, which is an issue because schools/daycare are still not open; there is no longer crisis care, so we are trying to advocate for an extension
- Postdoctoral scholars worried about sequelae of reduced productivity due to quarantine Yale should put together policies/guidelines to enable appointment extensions
- 2. Focus group: postdoctoral parents
 - Sean had started this previously
 - Krishna is really heading this group
- 3. Postdoctoral Townhall
 - E-mail from John Alvaro
 - Maikel: Nancy Brown/Scott Strobel/Mike Crair would be great.

 - Sean: Whom the admin sends depends on the questions that are asked, so ask more global questions, if you can.
 - Door to Door service? Maikel: Don't know because Yale fired these drivers.
 - Sean: Lack of support services such as shuttle drivers and child care will hurt those who are suffering the most.
