  - Past that time the document will be closed, reviewed and on the day of the meeting, we will discuss and vote for each suggestion.

- Budget FY25 increased but some committees will be negatively impacted.

#### Treasury [3 min]

• Budget updates for the fiscal year 2024-2025.

- Coordinators emphasized that committees need to plan and spend their budget each year to incentivize OPA/Yale to approve proposed budget increases for the subsequent financial year.
  - Certain committees did not spend their entire budget last fiscal year, and this year were awarded less than the proposed amount.
- The budget is not confirmed yet, and treasurers and chairs will attempt to negotiate further with the OPA.

### New purchasing procedures overview

- The treasurers described in detail the steps in which purchases should be made by YPA committees (form, pcard request, PO number). The updated guidelines are also outlined in the executive handbook that was circulated by the chairs in July. Should any members have questions, ask your committee coordinators!
  - The pcard is tax exempt in the state of CT, and you can request the vendor to take tax off of your receipt. To do so, provide the vendor with the number of the front of the card (the federal tax identification number). Utilizing this exemption will help the YPA budget go further, and coordinators are encouraged to make use of this tax-exempt status. Email the treasurers if you have any questions.
- Please submit your receipts as soon as possible after your event has occurred.

#### General

- **Website:** Update on our website-related meeting on Monday (August 12<sup>th</sup>) where we discussed final decisions to prepare for launching.
  - Website will be launched on Friday 23rd of August. The committee invite every coordinator to review their webpage and send an email to Sarah Smith with all URGENT request only. Minor one will be addressed after the launch of the website.
  - Sarah will email Coordinators during the week to provide more information and a link to access the website.
  - When adding upcoming events to the new website, be sure to tag your committee so that the event will also be displayed on the committee's webpage.

- **Post-event photos:** Interested in submitting photos of events that your committee planned (after the event has happened) to be posted on social media? Let's discuss: whose job is it to take photos, having a form for submitting photos, and considering consent to post.
  - Communications committee proposed that event organizers be responsible for taking pictures of their event and then send them to the Communications Committee (a form to submit photos will be created soon).
  - To obtain consent of participants to share photos, chairs suggested that adding a section to the Yale Connect registration form for events with the following sentence that is mandatory to check: "I give YPA permission to record my image and/or voice and grant YPA all rights to use these sound, still or moving images in any medium for educational, promotional, advertising, or other purposes that support the mission of the association. I agree that all rights to the sound, still or moving images belong to YPA".
    - If participants do not want to consent to their images to be recorded, but still want to attend the event the chairs suggested that another sentence can be added: "If you disagree with the use of your image, please contact XX".
    - A coordinator brought up that keeping track of who can be photographed and who did not consent may become challenging at large events or in the context of a group photo.
- Introducing YPA committees: Thoughts on proposed "Introducing the YPA" series on social media.
  - The communications committee coordinators suggested recording videos interviewing committee members that will then be posted on Instagram and saved in the highlights section.
- Merchandise: Update on merch for YPA.
  - New merchandise will be designed.
  - Attendees expressed support for another round of jackets and T-shirts.
  - Coordinators asked the chairs what the major issues for the last clothes purchase were. Chairs answered that:
    - 1 some people never picked up their orders
    - 2 collecting the money from postdocs was a significant challenge for the coordinators
  - Erin Heckler clarified that the YPA can NOT request that members pay for items, meaning the YPA will have to cover all expenses for the merchandise.
  - A suggestion brought up was to get quote from various companies, including YPPS.

  - For a non-Yale-affiliated speaker, they could be paid a *per diem*, and they could utilize that money themselves for travel or accommodations.

### **Mentorship Committee [3 min]**

- Quick updates on existing mentoring programs
  - Peer-mentorship program will be restructured, and registration will open in September.
  - Faculty-postdoc mentoring program registration will open in the next few weeks.
- Searching for a new leader for the Buddy Program (taking over from Peng Xu)
- Conceptualizing a new program "Building your Mentoring Team in practice". This program will help postdocs find professional and scientific mentors at Yale beyond your PI. Data shows that the more mentorship a postdoc has, the more successful they are.
  - looking for feedback by the postdoc community
    - Attendees were largely supportive of this program; however, some expressed the concern that it would not be taken well by their PI if they request another mentor. Coordinators will discuss this idea further with the OPA.
  - interested in experience from departments that already have something similar.
    - If your department has implemented something like this program, please reach out to the Mentorship committee coordinators with your experience.

# **Open Forum - Questions/Comments [15 min]**

A question was raised by an attendee about whether there is a common room on campus for postdocs to meet and feel welcome and in safe space.

- The chairs answered that there is no venue allocated for the YPA.
- There is a WhatsApp group where postdocs organize meetups.

The open forum ended.
