- <u>Visit to Halda Therapeutics</u>, a company based in New Haven observing their innovative work with RIPTAC<sup>TM</sup> therapeutics. The visit includes a meeting with Halda representatives, a behind-the-scenes lab tour and a Q&A session on career insights in biotech. - The Symposium Committee announced new subcommittee leads, requested a new member to lead the judging subcommittee, and discussed plans to improve the annual art contest. They also reviewed feedback from the previous symposium.
- Nicole DeMarais and Adina MacMahon Copas are the new Symposium Subcommittee leads for *Communications*.
- Anubha Seth is the new Symposium Subcommittee lead for *Events*.

  - Brief Description: The judging subcommittee lead is in charge of receiving submitted abstracts for the symposium (early next Spring), organizing the judges to evaluate said abstracts, and then assigning talks and poster sessions for the day of the event. #### Mentorship Committee [4 min]

- The Mentorship Committee provided updates on the faculty mentoring program, a workshop on navigating difficult conversations with mentors, and their search for new committee members to lead the mentoring network and instructor programs.
- New program Building Mentoring network we are developing the concepts and materials with OPA, we are looking for coordinators
- Faculty-mentoring program is running a new cycle this year all postdocs can participate in two groups to have more faculty mentors; orientation was successful with 20 new participants.
- Modern Instructor program: looking for new program leader.

Next Committee Meeting in late November 2024 (most likely via Zoom, exact date to be determined) Reach out to coordinators Dasha Zigackova (<u>dagmar.zigackova@yale.edu</u>) and Paris Filippidis (<u>paraskevas.filippidis@yale.edu</u>) if you would like to get involved or have more questions. • The Advocacy Committee shared results from their recent compensation survey, which found that 61% of postdocs are paid below the \$68k minimum and 85% are dissatisfied with their compensation. They are advocating for postdoc representation in compensation policy discussions with the administration.

#### **Compensation Policy efforts:**

- The Advocacy Compensation Survey has now closed.
  - Thank you to everyone who voted and gave us feedback.
  - We received 210 votes.
  - 61% receive below 68K, 15% receive above 68K.
  - A total of 84.6% are dissatisfied.
  - Results were shared on Twitter (detailed results/tables to follow)
  - We will interview with Yale Daily News to publicize our discontent and demands.
- We are advocating for Postdoc representation in compensation meetings with the Administration & HR. We have made some progress in this regard and will continue to work for better postdoc representation (a meeting scheduled end of November to present advocacy cases).

- The advocacy committee is working on a new complaint procedure with the OPA.
- An anonymous grievance survey is in preparation. Will be available from Yale Connect and on the Advocacy Website.

#### Other ongoing advocacy includes working with Chairs/OPA to push for:

- We have successfully secured an increase in annual PTO. This policy has gone into effect on 1st November 2024. PTO now includes Bereavement leave and compensated time off for postdocs working on official holidays. (https://postdocs.yale.edu/policies/policies-postdoctoral-appointments/benefits-23-paid-time)
- Holding a Town Hall to share and discuss the results of the 2023 Postdoc Experience Survey.
- Improved Yale shuttle experience and routes. We are working with the Graduate Student Assembly and Administration to improve shuttle services at Yale.
- We were informed that a postdoc rate for Payne Whitney Gym was under consideration and would likely go into effect from next semester. However, this has now been tabled in the budget for FY-2026.
- YPGA is also working on shuttle issue and can work together to improve shuttle services

  - Changes: combined sick and vacation time as PTO for a total of 23 days (includes 2 additional days), clarification on recess and holidays. Provides more flexibility for postdocs.
