- This data will be presented to the administration and used as a basis to target urgent issues.
- Thank you everyone who worked on preparing the survey, analyzing the data and presenting it.

4. Grievance procedure:

- Our committee members are working on a new complaint procedure with the OPA.
- We will advocate for Ombuds office together with other parties at Yale including faculty and students.
 - o An Ombuds office is a neutral (i.e., not officially a part of Yale) confidential resource that helps people resolve issues, brings systemic issues to the attention of Yale representatives, and helps trainees navigate the grievance procedure.
- Together with the Chairs we are scheduling a meeting with the new President.

5. Other ongoing advocacy includes working with Chairs/OPA to push for:
