# Associate Provost for Postdoctoral Affairs, Erin Heckler [3 min]

- National Postdoctoral Association annual conference OPDA and YPA participation
  - 4 people from the YPA are attending this year.
  - Victoria Hallinan will be presenting SPHERE for non-biomed postdocs.
  - The YPA Mentorship committee will be presenting a poster.
- Changes with the federal administration that impact postdocs:
  - Research: The Vice Provost for Research sent out a letter on Monday, Feb 3 <a href="https://research.yale.edu/federal-government-directives-grants?check\_logged\_in=1">https://research.yale.edu/federal-government-directives-grants?check\_logged\_in=1</a>. And the Research Office created a page with guidance on EOs and other federal administration changes that impact research <a href="https://research.yale.edu/2025-federal-administration-transition">https://research.yale.edu/2025-federal-administration-transition</a>. Erin is in communication with NSF Postdoc Fellows to help monitor the impact of not being able to access their fellowship funds and find solutions.
  - Immigration: OISS is keeping this page updated, including guidance on contacts with law enforcement and ICE <a href="https://oiss.yale.edu/immigration/immigration-changes">https://oiss.yale.edu/immigration/immigration-changes</a>. The guidance for faculty and staff is posted in our office.
    - o Regarding ICE raids, if you feel comfortable, print out "Know Your Rights" posters and put it in your area both at work and at home.

- The State of Connecticut Attorney General's press releases: <a href="https://portal.ct.gov/ag/press-releases/2025-press-releases">https://portal.ct.gov/ag/press-releases</a>. Including updates on the suit against the federal funding freeze.
  - o The CT Attorney general has been very active with law suits against the current administration, and the page on the CT Attorney General's website with press releases is very informative and up-to-date as things change rapidly.
- Some USDA grants have received stop work orders you will know if this is a grant that you are on.
- There are upcoming Town Halls for research administrators schedule to discuss these things, but how these orders will affect research and postdocs/ARS at Yale is still unknown.
- NSF postdoc fellows are paid directly and members of this community may not have received pay if you need help accessing emergency support regarding NSF funding, reach out to Erin Heckler at the OPDA.

#### Guest Presentation from the Yale Chaplain's Office [5 min]

The Chaplain's Office welcomes all, meeting trainees where they are, and respecting and honoring all identities that they hold. The Chaplain's Office is here to work with postdocs/ARS as well as students.

The Roles of the Chaplain's Office within the University include:

1. Connecting people to religious and spiritual life on Campus. Around 50% of those who reach out to the Chaplain's Office don't identify as spiritual. The Office works to connect people with their meaning and purpose in life.

2. Providing one-on-one meetings for confidential emotional support. While the staff are not therapists and cannot offer skill-based interventions, they talk with people about thing such as meaning, purpose, grief, and relationship stresses and dynamics.

The YPA and Chaplain's Office retreat will be held April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025, from 9am – 4pm at Mercy By The Sea in Madison, CT.

- There is space for up to 15 attendees.
- This retreat provides the opportunity for postdocs/ARS to get away from campus, connect with other postdocs.
- The theme of the retreat is "Finding Generative Roots".
- Registration has just launched through a Google form and a YaleConnect link is forthcoming.

# **Open Forum - Questions/Comments [15 min]**

Question - Should we be carrying documents/ID with us?

Response from Erin at OPDA - Check if OISS has current guidance on this. The OISS's page on "Recent Immigration Actions and Updates" can be found <a href="here">here</a>. There doesn't currently seem to be official guidance from Yale (or Immigration Lawyers) about this. Yale OPDA encourages you to do what you're comfortable with. It will likely be late March before federal immigration policies are officially updated.

Question - Will the YPA budget be affected if the federal government's forced lowering of indirect costs goes through?

The OPDA budget doesn't come from indirect funds, so it is unlikely, but the OPDA don't officially know for sure yet.

Many science journals have links to provide you with details on how to advocate for academic sciences. The ASM page titled: **How to Take Your Advocacy Message to Congress** can be found <u>here</u>. Please reach out and make your voice heard – representatives are responsive. You don't need to be a citizen or resident voter, just specify that you are a constituent in their area.
